Looking for another location in Morgantown. First Energy is to look again, don't have confidence in what they are not familiar with. This project would give them experience.

6. Livability solutions: Margaret Stout of WVU Public Administration faculty approached the City re: a grant for technical assistance around a variety of community issues. Asking for ideas from the green team. Green space, detailed energy use plan, traffic plan for high street, pedestrian mall; google livability solutions for more information.

7. Greenspace: Chris met with Bill Wonderlin on issue of Woodburn school site. Ron Justice is leading a team looking at site. Need a green team member on committee. Consensus is ask Bill to represent GT, Chris will ask.
